Leonardtown Resolution to Set Policy for Alcohol in Public Parks

WHEREAS, The Commissioners of Leonardtown passed Ordinance No. 182 on April 11, 2018 amending Chapter 36-Alcoholic Beverages of the Code of the Town of Leonardtown; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 182, section 36-2 provides that In accordance with Md. Code Ann., Alcoholic Beverages § 6-321, as amended from time to time, it shall be unlawful for any individual to consume an alcoholic beverage on public property within the corporate limits of the town except as authorized by any policies and procedures adopted and subsequently amended by resolution of the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, The Commissioners of Leonardtown will require an Alcohol Usage Permit to be requested for each public or private event to be held on Town property. The Alcohol usage permit is required to be signed by either the Mayor or the Town Administrator prior to the date of the event.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, from this date forward an Alcohol Usage Permit will be required for each public or private event held on Town owned property.
